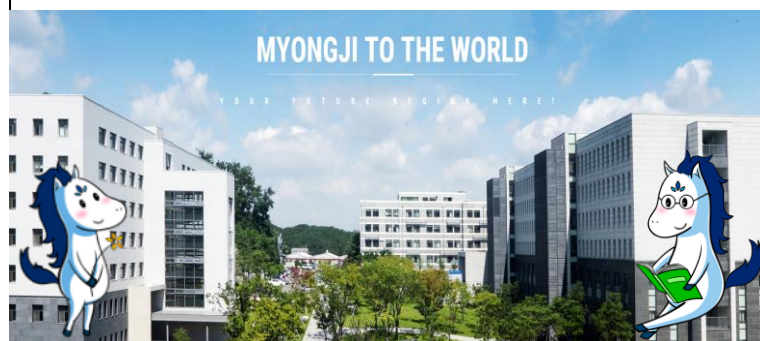

Insurance	Students must obtain their overseas insurance in their home country BEFORE they enter Korea (to be covered under a private insurance until their registration in Korea). Once they are officially registered in Korea, the following regulation applies: Mandatory National Health Insurance Service(NHIS): The Korean Government’s new health insurance policy requires all foreigners enrolled in programs offered by Korean institutions of higher education, which include exchange student program, to be subscribed to the National Health Insurance.			
Visa	Students must obtain D-2-6(Exchange Student Visa) BEFORE they enter Korea.

Vaccinations	<p>Myongji University requires all new students living in University Housing to be vaccinated and provide vaccination records to the Office of University Housing. Vaccination records include TB, Hepatitis A and B vaccinations and the Covid-19 vaccination.</p> <p>“Fully vaccinated” means having received both doses of a two-dose vaccine, such as the Pfizer, Moderna, or Astra-Zeneca vaccines, or one dose of a single-dose vaccine, such as the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.</p> <p><u>Tuberculosis (TB)</u> All international students are required to submit a negative TB Blood Test. A negative TB Skin Test is also acceptable. Another alternative is to have a chest x-ray performed to rule out pulmonary TB disease.</p> <p><u>Hepatitis A and B</u> laboratory evidence of immunity acceptable (within 1 year) If not, proof that you've received the combination hepatitis A & B vaccine (within 1 year)</p>
